- Treasurer Report: Jerome Gayster reported after deducting expenses and adding income from membership dues, our checkbook balance is \$1162.00. Jerry also reported we are running very low on cash and we may have a deficit by December. It was noted we would be receiving renewing members checks as soon as the AMA 2006 cards are issued so we should be alright..
- Membership 2005: 194 members as of the end of September have signed up for 2005. New 2006 membership forms have been mailed out with the newsletter, and are also available at the field. The newsletter was also sent out to past members and all current members this month. Due to not having a newsletter in September, the October newsletter was expanded. 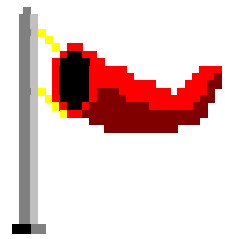
The Presidents Corner (Harry)

The President's Corner:

Our club's bank account is now below one thousand dollars and it was necessary for the club to increase our membership dues. Hopefully with the dues increased for next year we will be able to establish an emergency fund for any unforeseen events. My greatest concern is our rent has not changed in a long time and was originally based on the amount of taxes that were being charged for the land. I am sure that the taxes have been increased, but our payments to our landlord have remained the same. We are on a month-to-month lease of our flying field and this cost represents our highest expense each month. If we would have to pay for any back taxes we would be in serious need of funds immediately. This was the case in the past when the township changed the field assessment taxes from farmland to improved land when we had to come up with the difference in cost. Also, as can be seen in the minutes of the November meeting, we could use a new tractor mower and in addition some field repairs are required. With the increase in dues and hopefully with your membership renewal, we will enjoy another great year of flying at the Pine Barons field.

Although the weather is changing, with more wind and cooler temperatures, there is still a lot of good flying left this year. Some twenty plus club members were counted last weekend with temperatures in the upper 60's and not much wind. The forecast is again for nice weather this weekend so come on out and fly before the snowflakes start to fall. Don't forget we will still have the Frosty Finger Fun Fly on New Years Day, starting at 10 O'clock.
